Once Upon a Time <i>(Focus/Cognitive Skills/ Literacy)</i>	Story: Fairies are Real! By: Holly Hatam Concept: Fairies need a team to find fallen leaves, smooth stones, and tiny sticks for their woodland home. Learning: Children listen, retell, and take turns adding one treasure to the fairy basket	Listening Turn-taking Vocabulary: fairy, treasure, forest, wings
Kindness and Caring <i>(Self-help/Feelings & Kind Acts)</i>	Independence skill: Return an item to its place. Feeling practice: When a task feels hard, say, "I feel frustrated. I can try again, ask for help, or take a belly breath." Kind act: Offer a friend a turn. Help a friend.	Responsibility Self-help Problem solving Feeling word: frustrated
Exploration and Wonder <i>(Outdoor learning/ Magic of Cedarville)</i>	Fairy Trail Adventure: In pairs, follow picture clues outside to find a leaf, a feather, and a stick. Children decide together where each nature treasure belongs: soft, smooth, or rough. Reminder: Look, touch gently, then leave living things where they grow.	Teamwork Nature care Vocabulary: trail, pair, smooth, rough
Questioning <i>(Science/Tech./ Engineer/Math)</i>	How Can We Help the Fairy Cross the Puddle? Use blocks, bark pieces, or flat stones to make a safe bridge for a small fairy figure. If it falls, pause, try a new piece, or ask a teammate for an idea. Compare: Which bridge is long? Which is short?	STEM thinking Try again Compare Vocabulary: bridge, balance, long, short
Discovery <i>(Art/Sensory/Dramatic play)</i>	Create Fairy Nature Wands: Tie yarn around a stick and add fallen leaves or seed pods. Sensory Fairy Soup: Stir water, leaves, petals, and mud in a tub. Pretend to make a "brave try again" potion for a frustrated fairy.	Fine motor Imagination Vocabulary: wand, seed pod, stir, pretend
Moving and Grooving <i>(Gross Motor)</i>	Forest Friends Team Course: Carry a pinecone together on a tray, step over "logs," crawl through the fairy tunnel, and place the pinecone in the nest. Practice stopping, checking with a partner, and trying the next step.	Balance Coordination Cooperation Vocabulary: carry, nest, stop, together
